- *How do you bridge the gap between water-quality research and the management community that relies on this science?*
- *What are some common environmental contaminants and where do they come from?*
- *What are the most worrisome impacts of such toxins on aquatic organisms (e.g. fish populations)?*
- *How do you measure and determine an appropriate response to those impacts (i.e. through contaminant removal, etc.)?*
